

BOROUGH OF CRESSKILL

ORDINANCE NO. 17-01-1495

AMEND CHAPTER 44 – OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES  
ARTICLE VI – BOROUGH ADMINISTRATOR

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Cresskill in the County of Bergen and State of New Jersey, that the following ordinance replaces Chapter 128 as follows:

SECTION I

Qualifications.

The Borough Administrator shall be appointed on the basis of administrative qualifications with special regard to education and training in business and government affairs and experience therein. No elected member of the governing body may receive such appointment either during his term of office or within **thirty (30) days** after **termination of his service**. Preference may be given to a resident of the Borough of Cresskill, provided that said resident has the requisite administrative qualifications as outlined above; however, the Borough Administrator need not be a resident of the Borough of Cresskill in order to qualify for the office.

SECTION II

All other Ordinances of the Borough, or parts thereof, which are in conflict with this Ordinance, are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION III

If any section, subsection, paragraph, subdivision, or sentence of this Ordinance is adjudged unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall apply only to the section, subsection, paragraph, subdivision, sentence, clause, phrase or provision so adjudged, and the remainder of this Ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.

SECTION IV

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication according to law.
